- All articles entered by the 4-H member must be part of his/her project work for the 2022-23 4-H club year.
  4-H Classes at Dundas Exhibition will be open to all active 4-H PEI members .
- 3. 4-H Home Ec and Life Skill entries must be delivered to Heritage Hall at the Dundas Fairgrounds between 10:00am and 11:30am on Thursday, August 24.
- <u>4-H Horse & Pony Classes</u> Saturday, August 26 Horse show will be in the lower ring Registration - 8:30am at ringside Classes - begin at 9:00am
- <u>4-H Sheep and Goats</u> Saturday, August 26 In the cattle ring Registration - 9:30am at ringside Classes - begin at 10:00am
- <u>4-H Beef and Dairy</u> Saturday, August 26 In the cattle ring Registration - 9:30am - 10:30am at the announcer's booth by the cattle ring Classes - begin at 12:15pm, followed by Royal Beef Selection Class
- 7. There will be a Pee Wee Showmanship Classes (children under 9 years of age) on Saturday, August 26th, for sheep, beef and dairy. Please be ring side during the show if your child would like to participate. Participants must be accompanied by an adult and as with all Open Show classes, proof of insurance will be required for animals shown in this class.
- <u>4-H Canine Classes</u> Sunday, August 27 Canine show will be held in pony ring Registration - 11:00am - 12:00 noon in the Display Barn Classes - begin at 12:00 noon Due to lack of indoor facilities, if there is heavy rain, the Canine Show will be cancelled.
- <u>4-H Poultry Classes</u> Sunday, August 27 *Poultry show location TBA later this summer* Registration - 11:00am - 12:00 noon in the Display Barn Classes - begin at 12:30pm
- <u>4-H Rabbit & Cavy Classes</u> Sunday, August 27 Registration - 11:00am - 12:00 noon in the Display Barn
   Classes - begin at 1:00pm (Cavy show will follow immediately after the Rabbit classes)
- 11. Any displays and 4-H exhibits need to remain until Sunday and **must** be picked up at 4:00pm unless they are going to Evangeline on the 4-H Exhibition Circuit.
