## Scholarship Awards – Short Answer Questions

Application Deadline: Wednesday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at 5:00pm

### Applicant may choose to answer:

- One question in 300 words,

**OR**

- Two questions, each 150 words.

### Instructions:

- ✓ Short Answer Question/s should be typed
- ✓ Size 11 or 12 font, double spaced
- ✓ Answers should be in complete sentence, paragraph form and double spaced
- ✓ Spelling and content will all be taken into consideration.
- ✓ Any sources used within the answer must be properly cited within the text, along with a bibliography.
- ✓ Be sure to include title and your name at the top of page/s.
  - Member should choose an appropriate title to accompany answer – for an example, should you choose to answer question 1, an appropriate title could be *The Ways in Which Government Policy has affected the Canadian Agricultural Industry*. The chosen title should reflect the question so that judges can easily identify which question is being answered.

### Options:

1. The health care system in PEI, and across Canada, is seemingly in a crisis. How did we get here? What do you think it will take to build back a strong system on PEI to serve the population?
2. Bill C-18, the Online News Act, became law in June 2023. Canadians can no longer view news on Google or Meta platforms in a response to this. Has this impacted you or your family? How do you stay up to date with current events? What is your opinion of the Canadian government passing a law that means citizens can no longer effectively see the news?
3. What 4-H Project was most beneficial to you in your 4-H career, and why?
4. What are some of the important issues in your current or future field of study?
5. Free School supplies for grade K-9: present a short argument for, or against, high school grades (10-12) being excluded from this assistance.
