Thanks to your participation, the Member Advisory Committee (MAC) has now been recognized by the PEI Provincial Council Board of Directors as one of its Standing Committees!

Club MAC Rep

- This year, as a part of the election of your Club's Executive, you should also be electing Senior Member as your MAC rep. This is a ONE YEAR term (with the possibility of a one-time, one-year extension).
- MAC reps are responsible for representing your club members, collecting and sharing their ideas and recommendations with the Provincial Board of Directors.
- Some MAC Club reps from 2016-2017 have already indicated a wish to come back for a second-term so they should be given the option to do so, without the need of holding an election.
- MAC reps may also hold an additional role on the Club Executive. Each Club will have to determine this through elections.
- Clubs with no interested Senior member MAY elect an Intermediate member to take on this role.
- MAC reps will be invited and encouraged to attend Executive Training in November (date and location TBA)

MAC Meeting Expectations

In addition to their own Club meetings, MAC representatives are also expected to attend and participate in:

- as many of their District Council meetings as possible. MAC members are asked to attend 30 minutes before the start of the meeting, so they can share information and updates with their Regional MAC representative.
- Two in-person provincial-wide MAC representative meetings

Regional MAC Reps

Each Region (Western, Central and Eastern) also has a REGIONAL MAC rep who is appointed for a two-year term.

- Regional MAC reps share information to and from Club MAC reps with the Provincial Board of Directors and act as mentors for Club MAC reps in their region. Regional MAC reps are also responsible for the creation of the MAC Report which is presented at the Provincial AGM each February.
- Rae Matheson is the current Eastern Region MAC rep, completing the second year of her two-year term.
- There are currently vacancies for Regional MAC reps for the Western and Central Regions. Senior members interested in applying for one of these roles should submit their name to Administrative Director Kelly Mullaly as soon as possible and by no later than Friday, October 13.
